If Alex Borg has evidence, he must hand it over to investigators immediately

This morning, Alex Borg once again insisted that he had a basis for pointing towards Castille during the protest he organised following Wednesday evening's verdict, and for making the allegations he made. More time has passed, yet he has still failed to take any action.

Since the Leader of the Opposition is standing by these claims, the Labour Party expects him to immediately provide investigators with any evidence or information in his possession, so that these claims can be properly investigated and the truth established.

At such a serious moment, there can be no place for allegations made for political convenience. If Alex Borg genuinely has information that could assist an investigation, his responsibility is clear: he should hand it over to the competent authorities without delay. Anything less would raise serious questions about whether he is genuinely interested in establishing the truth and seeing justice served.
