### **Strong implementation in the first 100 Days of a new Government**

100 days into the historic mandate entrusted to us by the people, the Labour Party is looking ahead with determination, continuing to deliver on the electoral manifesto, 'Int Malta'. It is an ambitious programme, but one that reflects our commitment as a political movement to deliver what we promise, and to achieve even more.

The message delivered by Prime Minister Robert Abela at the the first 100 days of the new Government is clear: we will continue moving forward, guided by the values of social justice and a vision for a Malta that is increasingly progressive, modern and closer to the people.

The measures announced by the Prime Minister this morning further demonstrate the Government's commitment to building an innovative and diversified economy. These include the opportunity for young people to access free legal assistance when setting up a start-up, as well as stronger support for people seeking to develop new skills in Artificial Intelligence. This comes in addition to the announcement Dr Abela made on energy storage, another area where this Government is delivering stability and protecting consumers from price volatility despite the geopolitical challenges affecting energy markets.

The first 100 days have not been without their challenges. But we look ahead to this legislature with optimism, determined to continue working towards an ever-better Malta. These first 100 days have already demonstrated the strength of a Labour Government when it comes to turning commitments into concrete action.

We introduced measures in favour of families and took further steps to help more individuals become parents through reforms to the IVF law. We launched initiatives to strengthen enforcement within our communities. We set the planning reform process in motion. We strengthened the rights and protections of persons with disabilities, while work began on major projects in the health sector.

We introduced and strengthened schemes to help more people become homeowners, while also taking the first steps towards securing the future of White Rocks by granting the site protection as a national park. These are tangible results delivered during the first 100 days of a new Labour Government.

100 days of Government made possible by the people who placed their trust in this political movement. For us, that trust is a responsibility that we must continue to earn it every single day. The achievements of these first 100 days are not a reason to stop, they are the driving force behind our determination to achieve even more.
